After living with a very white kitchen that had unfunctional cabinets, the homeowner wanted a kitchen that inspired her, both with color and with cabinets that would actually "work." Since the walls could not be changed without major structural changes to the home, the focus was placed on the finishes in the kitchen. The first selection made was the golden kosmos, the granite for the countertops. This is the shining star for the kitchen. Since the homeowner did not care for stainless steel appliances but wanted the higher end refrigerator and dishwasher, we elected to put custom panels on them. By doing this, the large appliance, the refrigerator, is not the focal point in the kitchen; the granite, backsplash, cabinetry, and lighting become the focal points.

Custom-made handles are made for both the refrigerator and dishwasher that match the cabinet hardware used throughout the kitchen. The island has both a different color and style of cabinetry compared to the rest of the kitchen, allowing it to become another focal point. Overall the kitchen has a traditional pieces like the hand-blown glass pendants to make it timeless...what everyone wants in their design today.
